\* Season start and end dates are approximate and will be based on weather and water conditions.

\*\* These program fees **do not include** regatta entry fees, personal transportation, accommodation, meals or personal expenses. Only the youth competitive program fees include winter indoor training, available from November through April. Participants in the Youth Learn to Row Programs are able to access winter training facilities for an additional fee of \$50 plus HST as applicable.

Payment must accompany the registration form. All fees must be paid in full prior to using the facilities. Cheques for membership fees are to be made payable to *Kitchener Waterloo Rowing Club*. Cheques returned by the bank will be subject to an additional \$25 administrative processing fee. This processing fee is in addition to any fees charged by the bank.

Refunds will not be provided for any programs. Extenuating circumstances (e.g. medical illness or injury) will be considered on an individual basis. Such requests must be made in writing and submitted to the KWRC Board of Directors.

Participants will need to demonstrate a roll entry, swim 100 m and tread water for 2 minutes all while wearing shorts and a t-shirt. This demonstration of ability will be conducted at a local pool. (Location and cost to be determined.) It is highly recommended that participants have a minimum Level J or Swim Kids 7 swimming certification.

**Volunteer time:** KWRC is a member-run organization and, as such, it is expected that each youth competitive member will volunteer at least 5 hours throughout their rowing season. Volunteer time spent at KWRC is eligible for high school students looking to meet their requirement to complete 40 hours of volunteer time. Member participation ensures the success of our club and our programs. Volunteers are needed for activities such as:

- minor sports registration
- Row for Heart – Regatta Day
- open houses
- maintaining rowing equipment
- dock days
